#### Town Hall Hours of Operation

Town Hall is open to the public from 9 AM - 4 PM Monday through Friday. We look forward to serving you. Please do not come into the office if you have cold-like symptoms, are running a fever, and/or are not feeling well.

#### Spring Forward

Daylight Savings Time begins on Sunday, March 12, 2023, at 2 AM. Please make sure to set your clocks 1 hour forward. Governor Polis signed HB 22-1297 in November 2022, which would enable Colorado to remain on Daylight Savings Time year round. This cannot go into effect until passed at the Federal level. Should any updates become available, the Town will ensure the residents of Ignacio are aware.

#### Snow Removal

The Public Works Department is involved in snow removal operations. During snow storms, please park your vehicles in your driveway or garage and leave the street clear for snow plows. Also, the Town Code states that it is unlawful to plow, shovel, push, or place snow from privately owned property into any street, road, alley, or highway in the Town. Please help Town crews as they work hard to keep Town streets clear of snow and safe for your travel. If, during the efforts by Public Works to keep the streets safe, snow is placed on private property, it is the homeowner's responsibility to remove the snow from the property. Thank you.

#### Carbon Monoxide & Smoke Detectors

According to Colorado State Law, every home must have Smoke and C a r b o n M o n o x i d e Detectors installed. The smoke alarms must be installed both inside and outside of each sleeping room. Battery operated units should have a new battery installed every six (6) months.

#### Town Burn Pile

To drop off your tree limbs, grass clippings and other organic material at the Burn Pile, please call the on-call number (970-759-3660) to set an appointment. Please note that if the ground is muddy, access to the Burn Pile will be closed until conditions are satisfactory. NOTE: If people continue to dump unacceptable items, the Burn Pile will be closed indefinitely.

#### **Online Payments**

You can pay your Town utility bill ONLINE! Go to the Town's website townofignacio.colorado.gov and look for the "Pay Your Bill Online" link at the bottom of the home page. You will be charged a fee of \$1.00 for electronic checks, and \$0.75 + 2.25% of the transaction for debit or credit payments. #### Highway 172/Goddard Avenue Improvements

CDOT has awarded a contract for improvements to Highway 172 and includes Goddard Avenue. Improvements will include an asphalt surface overlay and new handicap ramps at several locations along Goddard Avenue. Some work will also entail sidewalk replacement at certain locations along Goddard Avenue. Work will begin in April and continue through the summer.
