## Carbon Monoxide & Smoke Detectors

According to Colorado State Law, every home must have Smoke and C a r b o n M o n o x i d e Detectors installed. The smoke alarms must be installed both inside and outside of each sleeping room. Battery operated units should have a new battery installed every six (6) months.

#### Town Burn Pile

The burn pile is available for disposal of your tree limbs, grass clippings and other organic material. Please note that, if the ground is muddy, access to the Burn Pile will be closed until conditions are satisfactory. # **Utility Billing Information**

The Town Board has approved the below temporary changes to the utility billing policy due to the COVID-19 Emergency Declaration:

- > Late fees are waived during the Disaster Declaration
- Utilities will not be shut off for unpaid utility bills
- Unpaid utility balances will need to be paid in full at the conclusion of the Emergency Declaration in order to avoid future late charges and shut-offs
