Dear Board Members,
As you are all aware, gas prices have skyrocketed and most of our customers will not be able to afford to pay the new rates. I would like to propose that, to assist our citizens with this unforeseen and unprecedented rate increase, the Town make the following temporary adjustments to our billing (only for the months of February through September 2023).
$>$ No late fees, beginning in January 2023 (loss in budgeted revenue is estimated to be \$6,000)
$>$ No reconnect fees (loss in budgeted revenue is estimated to be $\$ 1,500$ )
$>$ Office staff will apply partial payments to all other utilities first, including gas tax (the only balance on each account should be gas and possibly some of the gas tax)

I would also like to suggest the following adjustments:
$>$ Waive the $10 \%$ Capital Factor for the gas rate as long as the rate is $10 / \mathrm{MCF}$ or higher
$>$ No disconnections during the months of January through April
As you can see from the attached spreadsheet, June through September were the months where the cost of gas were the lowest in 2022. I would like to propose that the Town allow customers to spread the gas and gas tax payments over eight months, while still keeping current on all other utilities. This will prevent customers from losing their primary heat source during the extreme cold that we have been experiencing, and it will also (hopefully) help people to understand that we are doing our best to help them during this challenging time.

If a customer is behind on utilities other than gas and gas tax, we can look at resuming late fees, shut-offs, and/or disconnect fees beginning in September.

I look forward to receiving direction from you on this matter.
