Do not use your cell phone until you are outside and can no longer smell any gas. Call 911, the Fire Department (970-563-9501), or Dispatch (970-563-4401) if you smell gas at any time.

### Town Hall Hours of Operation

Town Hall is open to the public from 10 AM to 2 PM Monday through Friday. Phones are on from 9 AM to 4 PM Monday through Friday. If you need to come into the office before 10 AM or after 2 PM, please call to make an appointment.

### **Utility Rate Changes**

Water base rate has increased from \$26.48 to \$27.67; the rate per thousand gallons will remain at \$6.00 plus 10% Loss Factor and 5% Capital Factor.

Gas base rate has increased from \$23.75 to \$24.82; the rate per MCF will still be based on the SUUD rate plus 10% capital factor.

Sewer base rate has increased from \$14.84 to \$18.58. The Town is returning to an ERT model for sewer charges (1 ERT = 3,000 gallons); each ERT will be \$50.00. Sewer will continue to be charged based on water usage from the prior winter months, and the rate will be fixed for the entire year.

The only recycling cart size that is available is the 64-gallon size; the charge for this cart will be \$10.00. TDL will pick up all 35-gallon and 96-gallon carts and replace them with one 64-gallon cart. Please contact Town Hall if you wish to be removed from or added to the recycling route.

Irrigation Rates and Trash Rates remain unchanged.

If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact Town Hall.

### Snow Removal

During snow storms, please park your vehicles in your driveway or garage and leave the street clear for snow plows. Also, the Town Code states that it is unlawful to plow, shovel, push, or place snow from privately owned property into any street, road, alley or highway in the Tow. Please help Town crews as they work hard to keep town streets clear of snow and safe for your travel. Thank you.

### Town of Ignacio Elections

The polling place for the April 5, 2022 election is the Abel F. Atencio Community Room, 570 Goddard Ave., from 7AM to 7PM. There will also be ballot questions concerning the allowance and taxation of recreational and medical marijuana.

### Spring Clean Up

Spring Clean Up will be May 5-8, 2022, 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM all four days. Please bring a copy of your utility bill with you as proof of residency. No electronics, tires or chemicals accepted. Refrigerators will only be accepted if the Freon pump is removed, and it must be tagged by a licensed repairman.

### Carbon Monoxide & Smoke Detectors

According to Colorado State Law, every home must have Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors installed. The smoke alarms must be installed both inside and outside of each sleeping room. Battery operated units should have a new battery installed every six (6) months.

### Town Burn Pile

To drop off your tree limbs, grass clippings and other organic material at the Burn Pile, please call the on-call number (970-759-3660) to set an appointment. Please note that if the ground is muddy, access to the Burn Pile will be closed until conditions are satisfactory.

### Online Payments

### San Juan Basin Public Health WIC and SNAP Programs

Once again, the recently passed federal budget continuing resolution favored the WIC program with another continuation of an increased dollar amount for the fruit and vegetable portion of the WIC food benefits. Colorado WIC families will see the following increase on their WIC debit card through the end of March 2022: \$24/month for children, \$43/month for pregnant and postpartum participants, and \$47/month for breastfeeding participants.
