#### Town Hall Hours of Operation

#### Spring Cleanup

Spring Clean Up will be May 4 - 6, 2023, from 8 AM - 6 PM each day. Please bring a copy of your utility bill with you as proof of residency. No electronics, tires, or chemicals accepted. Refrigerators will only be accepted if the Freon pump is removed, and it must be tagged by a licensed repairman.

#### **Utility Announcements**

-An error occurred in the calculation of water billing for the months of January and February 2023, which resulted in utility customers being overcharged. This has been corrected going forward, and will be seen in the April 05, 2023 bill reflecting March 2023 usage. After the bills are mailed, your utility account will be credited to make up for the overpayments made for January and February water usage.

-GFL, the company contracted for residential trash removal, notified the Town on February 3, 2023 that the trash rates will be increasing by 6.1% CPI rate for trash collection. The rate for 1 poly cart will increase from \$11.40 to \$12.10, the rate for 2 poly carts will increase from \$17.50 to \$18.54, and the rate for 3 poly carts will increase from \$23.60 to \$24.98. This will be seen in the July 2023 bill reflecting June 2023 usage.

-Due to increased gas rates, the Town Board voted in February of 2023 to waive to late fees until April of 2023, and not perform utility disconnections until May of 2023. Please note, late fees will once again be assessed starting on the last business of this month, April 28, 2023. Disconnections due to nonpayment of utility bills will begin May 10, 2023, with a reconnect fee of \$50.00 assessed.

# Carbon Monoxide & Smoke Detectors

According to Colorado State Law, every home must have Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors installed. The smoke alarms must be installed both inside and outside of each sleeping room. Battery operated units should have a new battery installed every six (6) months.

#### Town Burn Pile

To drop off your tree limbs, grass clippings and other organic material at the Burn Pile, please call the on-call number (970-759-3660) to set an appointment. Please note that if the ground is muddy, access to the Burn Pile will be closed until conditions are satisfactory.

NOTE: If people continue to dump unacceptable items, the Burn Pile will be closed indefinitely.

#### Online Payments

You can pay your Town utility bill ONLINE! Go to the Town's website townofignacio.colorado.gov and look for the "Pay Your Bill Online" link at the bottom of the home page. You will be charged a fee of \$1.00 for electronic checks, and \$0.75 + 2.25% of the transaction for debit or credit payments.

### Highway 172/Goddard Avenue Improvements

Work on Highway 172 and Goddard Avenue has begun and will continue throughout the summer. Improvements will include an asphalt surface overlay, new handicap ramps and sidewalk improvements at several locations along Goddard Avenue. Town crews will also be working on sewer service replacements at certain locations along Goddard Avenue. Please monitor the Town's website and Facebook page for updates.

#### Low-income Energy Assistance Program

The Low-income Energy Assistance Program (LEAP) began on November 1 and runs through April 30, 2023. LEAP is a federally funded program and is administered by Discover Goodwill of Southern and Western Colorado. It is designed to help eligible low-income households with winter home heating costs. To apply, go to https://cdhs.colorado.gov/leap. If you received assistance last year, you need to reapply this year. They have a limited amount of funds for assistance with water and sewer; the application for that program is also online under Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP). Please note: April is the last month to apply for this season.
