### Mosquito Control

Vector Disease Control is contracted through the Town of Ignacio as your mosquito control provider. Please call VDC (970-560-6637) to report mosquito problems. It is important to remove standing water, where mosquitos lay eggs. Vector Disease Control treats water with larvacide and fogs streets and alleys when mosquitos are present.

### Weeds

The Town of Ignacio has ordinances in place that require you to ensure that your property is maintained in a visibly pleasing way (clearing of weeds and/or bushes that obstruct the line of sight, unkempt lawns, and trash). If you do <u>ANY digging</u> in the process of clearing or maintaining your property, you <u>must</u> call for line locates (dial 811).

Please remember to always lock your car and never leave valuables in it, especially not in plain view. This will prevent thieves from having easy access to your valuable items.

### Carbon Monoxide & Smoke Detectors

According to Colorado State Law, every home must have Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors installed. The smoke alarms must be installed both inside and outside of each sleeping room. Battery operated units should have a new battery installed every six (6) months.

To drop off your tree limbs, grass clippings and other organic material at the Burn Pile, please call the on-call number (970-759-3660) to set an appointment. Please note that if the ground is muddy, access to the Burn Pile will be closed until conditions are satisfactory.
