Town Hall Hours of Operation

Low-income Energy Assistance Program

The Low-income Energy Assistance Program (LEAP) began on November 1 and will run through April 30, 2024. LEAP is a federally funded program and is administered by Discover Goodwill of Southern and Western Colorado. It is designed to help eligible low-income households with winter home heating costs. To apply, go to https://cdhs.colorado.gov/leap. If you received assistance last year, you need to reapply this year.

Snow Removal

The Public Works Department is involved in snow removal operations. During snow storms, please park your vehicles in your driveway or garage and leave the street clear for snow plows. Also, the Town Code states that it is unlawful to plow, shovel, push, or place snow from privately owned property into any street, road, alley, or highway in the Town. Please help Town crews as they work hard to keep Town streets clear of snow and safe for your travel. In addition, should snow become placed on your property in an effort from Public Works to keep the streets safe, it is the homeowner's responsibility to remove the snow from their property. Thank you.

Trash & Recycling Pickup Update

- Due to the Christmas Holiday, trash pickup will be delayed one day the week of December 25, 2023, with pickup occurring on Thursday, December 28, 2023.
- -Due to the New Year's Holiday, trash pickup will be delayed one day the week of January 1, 2024, with pickup occurring on Thursday, January 4, 2024.
- -TDL Recycling will be closed the week of December 25, 2023. Recycling will not be picked up during that week. Recycling pickup during the week of January 01, 2024 will be delayed by one day due to the New Year's Holiday.

Carbon Monoxide & Smoke Detectors

According to Colorado State Law, every home must have Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors installed. The smoke alarms must be installed both inside and outside of each sleeping room. Battery operated units should have a new battery installed every six (6) months.

Call 811 Before You Dig

Whether digging a few inches or a few feet, Colorado 811 **MUST** be called to locate underground utility lines prior to any dirt being moved.
