- I. **CALL MEETING TO ORDER:** Mayor Pro Tem deKay called the meeting to order at 6:07 PM. She opened the meeting by leading in the pledge of allegiance. Mayor Pro Tem deKay asked Ms. Dunton to take roll call. Mayor Cox led the remainder of the meeting.

III. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Public Hearing on the Special Event Permit Application from Ignacio Chamber of Commerce Brisket Cook-Off, scheduled for October 9, 2021

Mayor Cox asked Mr. Garcia to give a background; he stated that he would hand it off to Ms. Dunton. Ms. Dunton stated that the Chamber completed the Special Event Permit (SEP) Application and asked Clark Craig, President of the Chamber, to give a background on the application. Mr. Craig stated that after the very successful event at the Green Chile Fest, Farmer's Fresh had approached the Chamber to host a beer tent at their Annual Brisket Cook-Off on October 9. They have several vendors and multiple competitors scheduled for the event that is sponsored by Farmer's Fresh. The Chamber is solely responsible for the beer tent. Trustee Melton asked for the times of the event. Mr. Craig stated that the event is scheduled from Noon to 4 PM; the SEP times are 11 AM to 7 PM, as the event may go longer than anticipated. Mr. Craig stated that all individuals will be carded and the event will have signs that restrict where the alcohol can be taken and that state that no outside alcohol will be allowed.

Mayor Cox opened the public hearing at 6:16 PM. There were no public comments. Mayor Cox closed the public hearing at 6:17 PM.

Action: Trustee Atencio moved to approve the application from the Chamber for the Brisket Cook-Off at Farmers Fresh on October 9. Trustee Melton seconded the motion. Mayor Cox requested a roll call vote; Trustee Craig abstained. The motion passed with six ayes and one abstention.

IV. MISCELLANEOUS


Clark Craig, 15682 Hwy 172, stated that he is part of the Ignacio Public Library Board. The Library will have a dedication for the portion of the Library that is being used to honor Naoma Jones on October 8, 4:00-4:30 PM. He extended an invitation for any Board Member to attend the dedication.


Trustee Craig gave an update on the CML Conference; she stated that the two key-note speakers will be amazing and suggested that all of the Board Members watch the videos if they are able.
