Dear Mayor Cox and Town Trustees,

First of all, I want to thank you for the Town's letter of support for the Tribe's grant application to the National Telecommunications and Information Administration. The Southern Ute Indian Tribe appreciates the Town of Ignacio's support.

As you know, the Tribe has been attempting to bring much-needed broadband connectivity to the Southern Ute Indian Reservation, which includes the Town of Ignacio.

In October 2020, the Tribe was awarded a 2.5 GHz license through the Federal Communication Commission's Rural Tribal Window initiative. The Tribe intends to leverage this spectrum to create a hybrid solution deploying fiber-to-the-home at select sites and middle-mile fiber for future scalability. The terms of the license require the Tribe to deploy its network and reach 50% population coverage in its license area by October 2022. To meet that challenging buildout requirement, the Tribe has been aggressively designing and engineering its network, conducting environmental and cultural resources reviews, initiating and completing permitting processes, preparing for construction, and applying for broadband deployment funding. All of these steps are critical to meeting the Tribe's license buildout requirements.

Phase I of the Tribe's broadband plan is depicted on the attached map and described in the attached one-page narrative. Upon request, the Tribe will make its environmental assessment of the project available to you.

In terms of public outreach and involvement, the Tribe has previously invited Reservation residents and is now inviting the La Plata County Board of County Commissioners and the Ignacio Town Board to comment on the Tribe's project.

Thank you for sending the above referenced letter to the Town seeking comments on the Tribes Proposed Broadband Project. This is definitely an exciting and much needed project for the Southern Ute Indian Tribe and its members. The Town has been very interested in the Tribes various broadband projects that are underway and communications have been exchanged through various tribal staff and the interim Town Manager. A call was completed on February 16<sup>th</sup> between Delbert Cuthair, Jeff Engman and Mark Garcia and this specific project was discussed. Communications are much appreciated and very helpful for broadband planning purposes.

The Town very much supports the Tribes efforts to expand broadband throughout the reservation. The Town does not have specific comments on the proposed broadband project details but would like to ask for an opportunity to collaborate with the Tribe if possible when fiber infrastructure is installed within or in proximity to the Town. The Tribes website shows fiber optic deployment through the Town of Ignacio in Priority 1, and this work may provide an opportunity for the Tribe and Town to collaborate. The Town completed and approved a Broadband Plan in February of 2022, which provides details on the extension of fiber to the premises (businesses and residents) throughout town. An opportunity to connect to Tribal fiber infrastructure within town would help accomplish the initial phase of this project. The Town faces the same broadband challenges as the Tribe and its members, and expansion of much needed high speed internet will greatly improve all of our lives and businesses. ### March 2022

Honorable Mayor and Trustees,

The following is a report on some of my activities since the Board Meeting in January.

#### **Elections:**

The Notice of Election must be published by March 16 to comply with TABOR regulations. The Notice of Election needs to be approved by the Board; it is on the agenda for this evening's meeting.

Per requirements of Statute, the TABOR Notice was mailed to all registered electors on March 1. A copy of the notice is attached to my report.

The ballot is at the printer and they should arrive at Town Hall no later than the 21st. I am planning to do a typical polling place election rather than the drive-through election that we did two years ago.

#### Licenses:

Animal: 40 current – Reminder letters were sent to the 13 dog owners that have not yet renewed. Business: 62 current – Reminder letters were sent to the 7 businesses that have not yet renewed.

Business Service: 60 current Liquor: None for this month

#### Treasurer:

The finance reports for February 2022 are included in the consent agenda.

In the February 25 CML Newsletter there was an article about the Paid Family Medical Leave Insurance Program (see attached copy of this article). Beginning in 2023, this program includes all municipalities by default, unless there is a vote by the governing body to opt out of the program (this vote must be retaken every 8 years). I would appreciate guidance from the Board as to whether you would like the Town to enter into the program or if you want to opt out.

- ➤ If the Town enters the program, based on this year's total salary numbers, the cost would be \$9,823.00 for the entire year (50% of this cost is on the employer and the other 50% comes from the employee and is based on their earnings). These premiums are collected each pay period and remitted to the Department of Labor & Employment quarterly. The Town would begin collecting premiums in January 2023 and benefits would become available in January 2024.
- If the Town opts out, an individual employee can still opt in and pay their premiums directly. If you have any questions, I would be happy to answer them.

### Meetings Attended:

I attended the Ignacio Creative District Board Meeting, the Ignacio Creative District Work Session, the Chamber Board Meeting, and the Chamber General Membership Meeting.

#### **Events:**

The Town of Ignacio Regular Municipal Election will be on April 5. The new Mayor and Trustees will be sworn in at the regular Town Board Meeting on April 11.

## What municipalities need to know about FAMLI

In November 2020, Colorado voters approved Proposition 118, which paved the way for a state-run Paid Family Medical Leave Insurance (FAMLI) program. Although the program is not effective until January 2023, now is the time to start making decisions regarding your municipality and FAMLI participation and compliance. Local decisions can impact budgets, employee compensation, and human resources issues.

#### Overview of FAMLI

FAMLI provides workers 12 weeks of paid leave to take care of themselves or a family member during life events like injury, serious illness, or pregnancy. Participating employers and employees will contribute to premiums for FAMLI. Employers start collecting and remitting premiums Jan. 1, 2023, and benefits will be available starting Jan. 1, 2024.

Premiums are calculated under new administrative rules. A participating municipality must contribute 50% of the premium and the employee contributes the remainder. If a municipality does not participate, the employee is responsible for 50% of the premium and the municipality can, but need not, deduct the employee portion from payroll and remit it to the state. A municipality that miscalculates premiums is responsible for the difference and cannot collect that amount from the employee.

#### **Opting out**

All municipalities are included in FAMLI by default, but a municipality may opt out and avoid the employer portion of premiums by a vote of a governing body. The municipality must give prior notice of the vote in the same manner it notices other public business, must provide special notice to employees, and must take testimony before voting. Declination takes effect in 180 days so employees can

individually opt in to the FAMLI program at their own cost. Within 30 days of the vote, a municipality must provide various notices that include:

- An explanation of differences between the FAMLI plan and any municipal private plan
- Employee eligibility for job protection under the federal Family and Medical Leave Act
- Information on opt in to FAMLI
- Contact information

All notices, whether for opting out or back in, must be posted in conspicuous and accessible places where employees work. If the municipality does not maintain a physical workspace or has employees who telecommute, the notice must be posted in a conspicuous place through a web-based or app-based platform. Notices must be posted in English and any language representing the first language spoken by at least five percent of the local government's workforce.

Administrative rules require that a municipality renew its decision to opt out of FAMLI every eight years. Otherwise, the local government will, by default, be opted back into the FAMLI program. A vote to opt out starting in 2023 should occur by July 1, 2022, to ensure compliance with the timing requirements.

#### Opting back in

A municipality that previously opted out of FAMLI may opt back in if the governing body elects FAMLI program coverage at the beginning of the annual local budgeting cycle. After the vote, the municipality must register as an employer with the FAMLI Division before collecting employer premiums. Coverage would begin no later than the first quarter after the municipality's notice to the FAMLI Division of the vote and submission of at least one quarter's premium amount on

behalf of the employer and its employees. Municipalities who opt into FAMLI must stay in the program for at least three fiscal years. The first year begins on the first day of employee coverage — not the first day a municipality collects premiums.

No more than 90 days after the vote, individual employees who opted in must be personally notified in writing that the municipality has opted back into FAMLI. The notice must include that date for the municipality's first submittal of quarterly premiums and any potential lapses or changes in benefits eligibility.

The local government must publicly post a notice of the date the employer will begin paying FAMLI premiums and when coverage is expected to start.

Employees who did not opt in must also be notified in writing both publicly and personally no later than 180 days after the vote to opt back into FAMLI. The notice must contain a detailed explanation of employee rights under the FAMLI program, including program requirements, benefits, claims processes, payroll deductions, premiums, and employee protections like the right to job protection and benefit continuation and protection against retaliatory or discriminatory information, among other things.

#### **Additional resources**

The Colorado Supreme Court recently agreed to hear an immediate challenge to FAMLI premiums brought under TABOR. The Denver District Court upheld the FAMLI premium requirement in 2021. Additional Information regarding FAMLI can be found at famli.colorado.gov.

## **Town Managers Report**

**DATE:** March 11, 2022

**REPORT PERIOD:** February 12, 2022 – March 11, 2022

This report focuses on items within the Town Board Meeting Agenda and also on work completed during the report period listed above.

### **TOWN BOARD MEETING AGENDA ITEMS**

#### VI. NEW BUSINESS:

A. Notice of Election: This is a required election notice which Tuggy will discuss with you.

B. SUIT Proposed Broadband Project Support Letter: In your packet is a letter from Chairman Baker regarding the tribes proposed broadband project and an opportunity to comment on their project. I met with Jeff Engman, CIO, and Delbert Cuthair on February 16<sup>th</sup> and discussed this project in detail. Although the comment period has passed, I think it would be important to submit an additional letter of support for this project and also request collaboration with the Town, when and if possible. In our discussions, it appears there will be fiber optics and additional conduit laid through Town along Goddard Avenue, and this is where potentially the Town can utilize the fiber infrastructure for Town connectivity. The Town has a Broadband Plan which was adopted at the February meeting and this plan details how a fiber to the premises build can be deployed throughout town. Town ARPA funding and other grants may be a good source for extension of fiber throughout Town and having fiber connectivity is essential for such a project.

I have been in communication with Lindsay Box regarding a Town letter and she suggested we submit the letter for consideration by the Tribal Council. Enclosed is a draft letter for your review and consideration. I will also report on other regional broadband initiatives that are underway and that I have been involved with during this agenda item.

C. COVID-19 Update: This is an ongoing agenda item. Positive COVID cases are on a significant decline at this time and La Plata County emergency status has been reduced to "Medium" status. San Juan Basin Public Health Department is still under an Emergency Declaration for the COVID 19 pandemic, and the Town of Ignacio is still under an emergency declaration. The Town Resolution (06-2020) adopted in March of 2020 states, "This Resolution shall be effective upon the date below, and shall remain in effect until SJBH or the State have lifted their emergency declarations, or the Town has taken specific action to lift this emergency declaration. Copies of this signed Resolution will be filed promptly with the Colorado Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, the La Plata County Clerk and Recorder and the Town Clerk." As such, the Town is still under an emergency declaration. I have

been in contact with SJBPH regarding their declaration and informed that any changes to the declaration will come from the Health District Board. I do not have any other COVID information to share at this time.

#### VII.D TOWN MANAGER REPORT

Town Storm Drainage Project: The Town storm drainage utility has had problems for years and Jeremey has prioritized this project for this year. SEH has developed a plan and design for repairing this utility. I have written and submitted an EIAF Grant for \$200,000 which will require a \$200,000 match. The total plan cost was approximately \$2.8M if contracted out. The public works crews have looked at doing the pipe excavation and install work and in doing so brings the costs down to \$1.6M. This project and associated cost will require a phased development plan and the first phase will be funded by the EIAF grant and Town matching funds totaling \$400,000. The 2022 Capital Improvement budget identifies a \$100,000 capital project expense but doesn't define the project. If this grant is awarded I would suggest we utilize CIP funding which has ample funds for this project. A supplemental budget will be required if the project becomes reality. Grant awards will be in June of 2022, so if awarded, the first phase of this project can occur this year. Please contact Jeremey or I with any questions.

Ignacio Downtown Redevelopment Plan: The University of Colorado Technical Assistance work is underway. As of this report writing, I do not have any news or updates to provide. This work is instrumental in the overall downtown development plan for Ignacio. We will keep you apprised of this work and provide information when it becomes available. Thank you.

Space to Create (S2C) Project: Previously, I reported that I was looking at whether Ignacio would be a good fit for a S2C project and was using a consultant to help work through the details. Through this work and with some good graces, Ignacio has been designated as an eligible project town. There are a total of nine (9) communities identified statewide and this is an exciting opportunity for Ignacio. This initiative is led by the Colorado Creative Industry which is a state office within the Office of Economic Development and International Trade (OEDIT). Initial funding and support is provided by the Boettcher Foundation. There is a lot of work involved in this endeavor and will require multiple funding commitments (grants and loans) and a financial commitment from Ignacio. As you will read, Artspace is the lead consultant working on the market and feasibility studies. Representatives from Artspace traveled to Ignacio from Minnesota on March 2<sup>nd</sup>, and toured various sites in town. They were excited about the prospects and now have a better idea on the potential here. A formal press release will be completed once a few more details are worked out over the next couple of weeks. Tentative market and feasibility work is scheduled for late summer/early fall. The Ignacio Creative District is going to be an integral entity in this project and possibly the SUIT. We will continue to work on this project and with keep stakeholders and will keep you apprised of work and progress.

<u>Grant Writing</u>: Region 9 has hired a grant writer who is tasked with supporting towns with limited staff and grant writing capabilities. We have met with their new grant writer and identified a number of grants that can be pursued for various Town projects. Town staff will be working with

this grant writer and pursuing a number of grants in the coming months. More details will be provided during this meeting.

Regional Housing Alliance: The RHA has awarded a contract to a couple of firms who collectively submitted a proposal to work on a defined scope of work that will look at county-wide housing issues. A lot of work has already been completed by the Economic Development Alliance and the SWCCOG. Mayor Cox is one of our representatives on this board and we will need a new rep once her term is complete. Please contact me with any questions and if interested in representing the Town on this board.

<u>Southwest Colorado Council of Governments (SWCCOG)</u>: The SWCCOG is also experiencing challenges and substantial work has been required. The future of the SWCCOG is under consideration and a retreat is planned to consider next steps for the organization. The scheduled retreat was cancelled due to the COVID spike in January. I will report back on decisions and directions for the SWCCOG

<u>Zito Media License Agreement:</u> The draft cable franchise agreement has been completed and forwarded to Zito for their review. I have not heard from them with any comments. I will apprise you of any activities on this agreement.

<u>MEETINGS ATTENDED</u> – I continue to attend numerous conference calls and webinars remotely on a variety matters, as well as on the local and state response to the COVID-19 crisis. I have also been actively involved in meetings and calls on the RHA and SWCCOG with both entities involved in restructuring. I continually exchange multiple emails and phone calls on related town matters and projects.
