Acceptable recyclables:

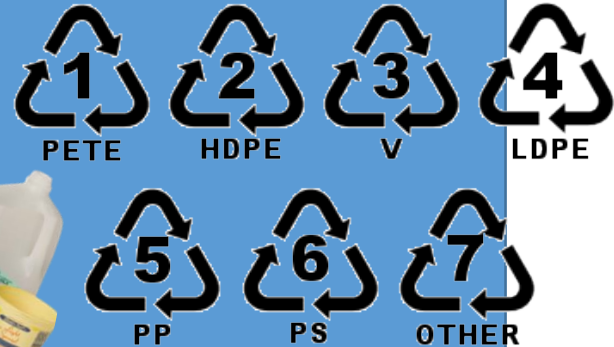
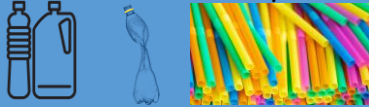
PAPER

- ✓ Mixed paper
- ✓ Paper bags
- ✓ Paperback books
- ✓ Phone books
- ✓ Magazines
- ✓ Shredded paper (bagged)
- ✓ Corrugated cardboard
- ✓ Cartons and paperboard



PLASTIC

- ✓ #1 Polyethylene Terephthalate
- ✓ #2 High Density Polyethylene
- ✓ #3 Polyvinyl Chloride
- ✓ #4 Low Density Polyethylene
- ✓ #5 Polypropylene
- ✓ #6 Polystyrene
- ✓ #7 Other (BPA, Polycarbonate and LEXAN)



ALUMINUM

- ✓ Aluminum cans
- ✓ Pie plates
- ✓ Foil
- ✓ Loose metal jar lids
- ✓ Steel cans

TDL Recycling Guidelines

Recycling containments

Please do NOT put the following in recycling:

NO glass

Please do not place glass inside of TDL single stream recycling carts. Be sure to place all glass in designated glass carts for TDL Recycling.

NO liquids or food residue

Please make sure that all recycling is clean and empty. A rinse only takes a second!

NO scrap metal

Please do not place scrap metal items of any size in TDL Recycling.

NO non-recyclable plastics

TDL accepts plastics #1-7 but there are some plastics that are **not** recyclable. These products include Styrofoam® , bubble wrap of any kind, hard plastic items including toys, plastic chairs, flower pots, PVC pipes and any other plastic products that are not listed in these guidelines.

NO electronics

Please do not place electronic devices of any kind in your TDL Recycling carts.

NO hazardous waste

Please do not place any hazardous waste in TDL Recycling carts, this includes oil-based paint, automotive fluids, car batteries, fertilizers and pesticides.

NO garbage

Please do not place food waste, toys, diapers, soiled paper or any other garbage items TDL Recycling.
